Monal Patel, Associate Vice Provost for Institutional Research and Decision Support

- -There is a ongoing effort to collect data on graduates as they leave VCU
- -The survey is called the "First Destination Survey" and seeks to collect important information from graduates to see how aligned their degree is with their career
- -The data can also serve as an important tool for marketing
- -The current response rate is about 30%-32% with the goal of having 50% response rate
- -Patel will send outcome reports to Street to share

- -Dr. Kim Case was hired as the new Director of Faculty Success and her starting date is August 15,2019

- -There will be a celebration in June for Dr. Cathy Howard, Vice Provost for the Division of Community Engagement, who is retiring after 31 years of service

- -On Friday, April 26, the Center for Teaching and Learning Excellence (CTLE) had a celebration of teaching event with over 50 faculty proposals and 75 attendees
