The Interactive Accommodation Process

- Student discloses disability and need for academic accommodations
- Student provides supporting documentation for request
- DAS reviews request and documentation
- DAS determines reasonable accommodations
- As needed, DAS interacts with student and faculty to ensure that the reasonable accommodation will not alter the learning objective or technical standard being measured
